Currently, 47.4% of the 20,399 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 43.5%, renter occupied; and 9.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 14,687 housing units in the area - 50.5% owner occupied, 39.7% renter occupied, and 9.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 15.72%. Median home value in the area is \$217,090, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.63% annually to \$247,176.
